A complete schedule of all process waters and industrial wastes produced or expected to be produced at said property, including a description of the character of each waste, the daily volume and maximum 30-minute rates of discharge including any monthly or seasonal variations, if any, representative analyses, and the ability of the existing system to comply with the revised ordinance.
- D. If additional treatment facilities will be required to comply with the ordinance attach a proposed compliance schedule.
- E. If additional treatment facilities will be required, attach a preliminary drawing and description of the proposed treatment units.
- F. Attach detailed drawing of the control manhole you propose for the JSA's use in monitoring your facility.

9. In consideration of the granting of this permit, the undersigned agrees:

- A. To furnish any additional information relating to the installation or use of the industrial sewer for which this permit is sought as may be requested by the JSA.
- B. To accept and abide by all provisions of the JSA ordinance, and of all other pertinent ordinances or regulations that may be adopted in the future.
- C. To operate and maintain any waste pretreatment facilities, as may be required as a condition of acceptance into the wastewater treatment system of industrial wastes involved in an efficient manner at all times, and at no expense to the JSA.
- D. To cooperate at all times with the JSA and its representatives in their inspecting, sampling, and study of the industrial wastes, and any facilities provided for pretreatment.
- E. To notify the JSA immediately in the event of any accident, or other occurrence that that occasions contributor to the wastewater or substances prohibited or not covered by this permit.
- F. To incur all expenses involved during each monitoring visit by the JSA in; sampling, inspection, in-house and contracted laboratory analysis, administrative costs, and any technical, engineering, and/or legal assistance required.
